- 1. KEC Mission:** The Kansas Energy Council develops energy policy recommendation and delivers them on an annual basis to the Governor, Legislature, and Kansas Corporation Commission.
- 2. Guiding Principle:** The Kansas Energy Council Develops policy recommendations to ensure the wise use of energy resources by Kansans over the long term.
- 3. Purpose of the KEC Goals Committee:** To identify long-range strategic goals to guide the KEC planning process.

Such goals should be consistent with the following standards:

- i. Wise Use Standard
  - A. Maximizes the total welfare of Kansans,
  - B. Promotes sustainability of non-renewable resources,
  - C. Is economically efficient,
  - D. Minimizes waste of resources,
  - E. Minimizes the total costs (that is, internal and external costs) of consumption,
  - F. Promotes/maximizes economic development, and
  - G. Makes the most out of Kansas' scarce energy resources.
- ii. Priority Standard
  - A. Political feasibility
  - B. Technical feasibility
